The Black Chamber of Commerce of Palm Beach County is delighted to present the 4th Annual MLK5K and Divine Nine 5K Challenge. Once again our team of volunteers will be bringing the community together to pay tribute to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. in a fun and healthy way.

With an expected 500 participants this year, the MLK5K and Divine Nine 5K Challenge is quickly becoming one of the fastest growing and most diverse athletic events in our area. The funds raised by this event help provide needed training and other support services for aspiring entrepreneurs who are realizing their dreams while providing employment opportunities in mostly under-resourced areas.

Dr. King dedicated his life to helping others overcome racial, socioeconomic and health disparities. We invite you to partner with us as we walk, run and soar our way into a brighter and healthier future for all Palm Beach County residents.







Your sponsorship helps address these business disparities:

- Revenue Disparity: Black-owned businesses generate significantly less revenue than white-owned businesses. On average, Black-owned businesses have annual sales of around \$58,000, compared to \$552,000 for majority-owned businesses.
- Access to Capital: Black entrepreneurs face more significant challenges in securing capital. They are more likely to be denied loans, and when approved, they receive smaller loan amounts at higher interest rates than their white counterparts.
- Business Size: Black-owned businesses are more likely to be sole proprietorships or small businesses with fewer employees. Only 4% of Black-owned businesses have paid employees, compared to 23% of majority-owned businesses.
- COVID-19 Impact: The COVID-19 pandemic disproportionately affected Black-owned businesses. By mid-2020, the number of active Black-owned businesses fell by 41%, compared to a 17% decline for majority-owned businesses.
- Wealth Gap: The racial wealth gap contributes to disparities in business ownership. Black families have, on average, one-tenth the wealth of white families, making it more challenging for Black entrepreneurs to start and grow businesses.
- Access to Mentorship and Networks: Black entrepreneurs often lack access to the same networks and mentorship opportunities that white entrepreneurs benefit from, which can be crucial for business growth and sustainability.
