Dicky Sykes was an enthusiastic community leader, advocate, and mentor. Throughout her career, she worked tirelessly to promote equity as the core principle in business practices. Her goal was to enable minority and women owned businesses to get a larger piece of the pie. Dicky had a simple philosophy, "Engage and involve all stakeholders, including corporate America and local government, use innovation, creativity and technology to make supplier diversity fun and create value propositions for all parties."

Dicky moved to West Palm Beach in 2017 to begin work with the School District of Palm Beach County as Director of the Office of Diversity in Business Practices. Weeks after her arrival, she was diagnosed with stage 3 ovarian cancer. Dicky joined the Black Chamber in 2017. While in the personal battle of her life, she continued to make strides for equity and inclusion in the District and the Chamber. 


